The Construction Battalions

"SEABEES"

The "SEABEES" are the men who enlist in the Construction Battalions of the U. S. Navy to build the advance and mobile bases anywhere in the world.

The "SEABEES" are thoroughly trained in military tactics and they defend what they build.

The U. S. Navy has openings, with ratings, for men with construction experience in Class V-6 of the Naval Reserve for assignment to headquarters and construction companies in a Construction Battalion. These headquarters and construction companies are comprised of carpenters, concrete workers, electricians, longshoremen, automotive repairmen, plumbers, machine operators, wharfbuilders, welders, shovel operators, etc. Acting appointments are made to persons between the ages of 17 and 50 in ratings up to and including Chief Petty Officer, depending upon the age, experience and other qualifications of the personnel enlisted.

The salaries paid in the various ratings range from \$54.00 to \$126.00 a month and include housing, food, clothing, transportation, medical and dental care, and other incidentals to which enlisted personnel are entitled.
