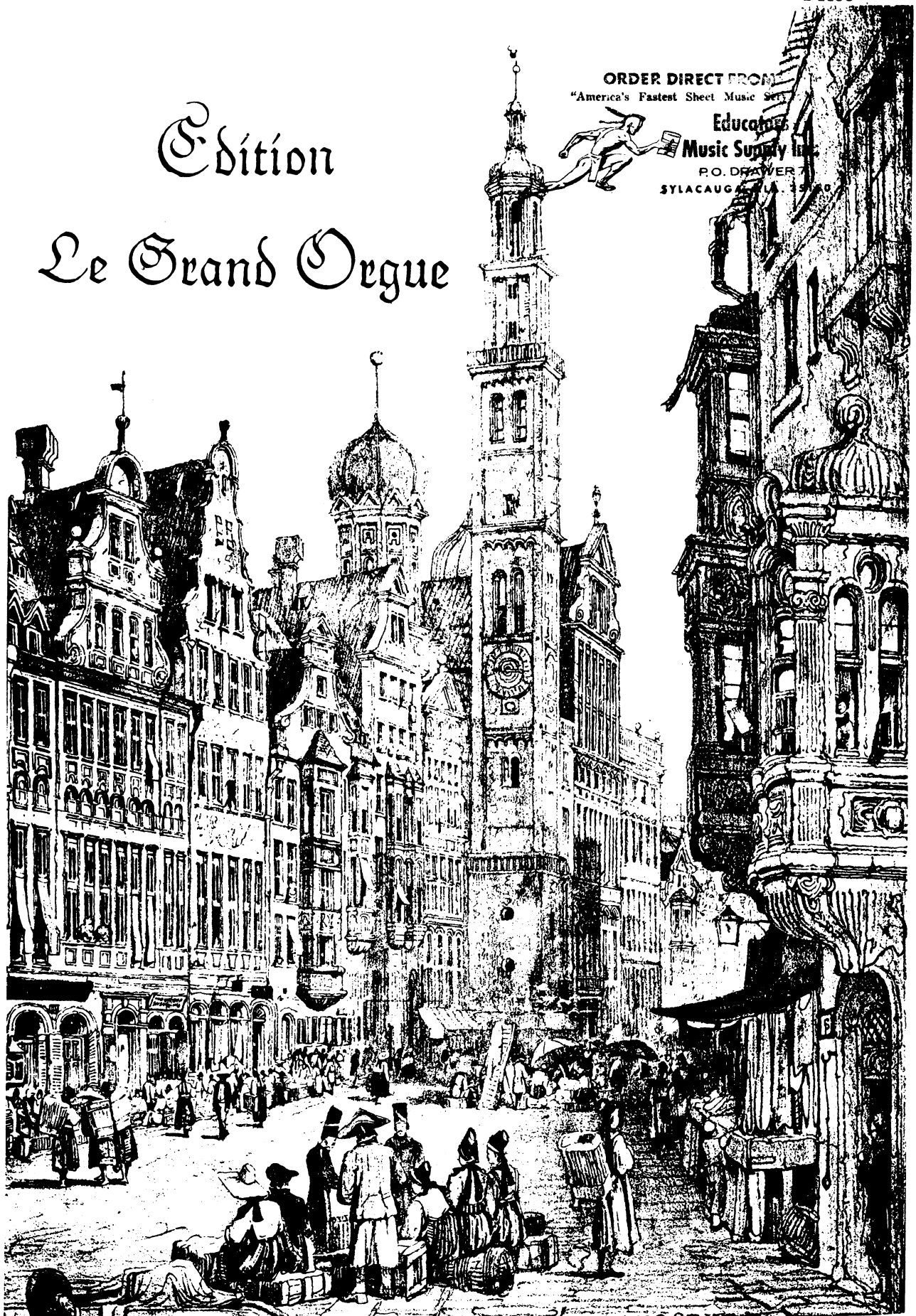

Andantino senza rigore
