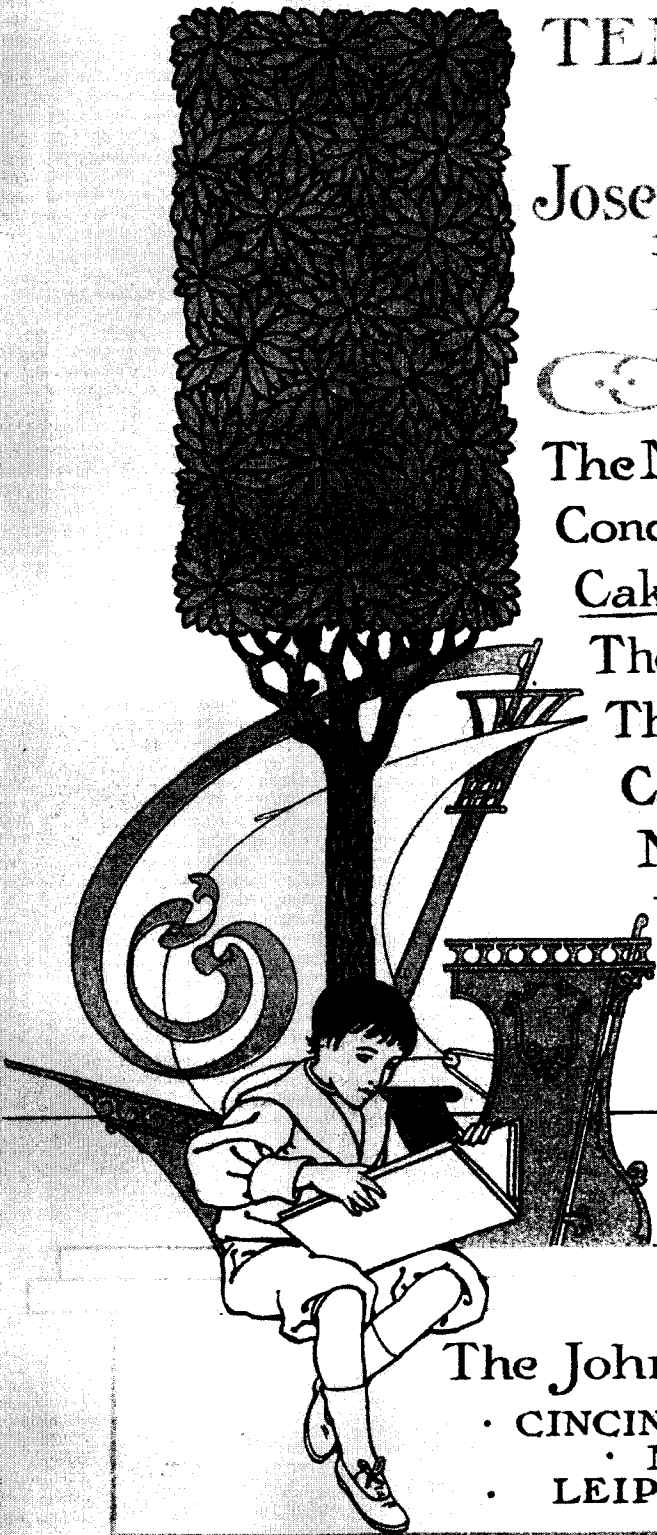

And he said,so did he.

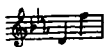
It lasts, as if the Music still,
