Second system of the cello part, continuing with piano (*p*), crescendo (*cresc.*), and mezzo-forte (*mf*) dynamics.

Third system of the cello part, featuring mezzo-forte (*mf*) and a diminuendo (*dimin.*) marking.

Fourth system of the cello part, marked *a tempo.* with a tempo change to *e poco rallent.* and *p ma espress.*

Fifth system of the cello part, featuring fortissimo (*sfz*), pianissimo (*pp*), and mezzo-forte (*mf*) dynamics.

Sixth system of the cello part, marked piano (*p*) and crescendo (*cresc.*).

Seventh system of the cello part, marked mezzo-forte (*mf*) and crescendo (*cresc.*).

Eighth system of the cello part, marked mezzo-forte (*mf*), crescendo (*cresc.*), and fortissimo (*f*).

Ninth system of the cello part, marked mezzo-forte (*mf*) and crescendo (*cresc.*).

Tenth system of the cello part, marked piano dolce (*p dolce*), calando, and pianissimo (*pp*).
